The Expert talk was intended to give an insight on various issues of Women internet safety. 80+ students from BBA participated actively in the session. The event was hosted by Dr. Naga Rathna Supriya and it started with the UTU anthem. Dr. Yagna Vyas introduced all about the speaker. Dr. Chintan narrated about the growing reach of the Internet and the rapid spread of information through mobile devices has presented new opportunities that could put women at risk. He discussed different live examples of his career where women became victim due to negligence of Internet safety. He highlighted on different forms of online harassment such as unauthorized accessing of personal profiles to obtain private information and using fake social media profiles for extortion. Later on he informed about the type of cyber crime with some examples like Sharing embarrassing and cruel content about a person to impersonation, Stalking and electronic surveillance, non-consensual use of photography, defamation etc.

Dr. Chintan informed the participants about the necessary steps that we should take if we get trapped in Cyber crime. He informed about the working style of fraud persons and scammers so that we could understand and save us from being victims.

A valedictory function was arranged soon after the completion of the session along with participants' feedback. The seminar was a grand success with nice presentations and interactions.
