The Resource Person Dr Anant Vyas Sir enlightened students with the need and urgency for understanding documentation process for EXIM and role of liaisons with custom officers.

- 4. Procurement process of EXIM licenses*
- 5. File bill of entry and other documents for custom clearances*

6. Determination of import duty and rule for clearances of goods

The *Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-2020* mandates the following commercial documents for carrying out importing and exporting activities:

- Bill of lading or airway bill;
- Commercial invoice cum packing list;
- Shipping bill or bill of export, or bill of entry (for imports).

The important regulatory documentation and its implications to exporters

- GST return forms (GSTR 1 and GSTR 2);
- GSTR refund form;
- Exchange Control Declaration;
- Bank Realization Certificate; and
- Registration cum Membership Certificate (RCMC).
