Executive Summary (2012-13)

The academic session of the college began on 16th June 2012. This year college admitted 181 students in first year of BBA and B.Com (Computer Application) courses.

A week long orientation programme was conducted for 181 students of first year BBA and B.Com from 2/7/2012 to 7/7/2012. The objective was to acclimatize the newbies with our system and culture. Famous laughter therapist Shri Kamlesh Masalawala explained the significance of laughter. A series of practical exercises were taught and the training hall echoed with belly jerking laughter during the entire session. Members of Surat Nature Club organized adventure sports 'Flying Fox', for the new comers. 'Miss. Rozy Patel a talented radio jockey and an expert in etiquette training took a session on grooming and behavior of college students. Shri Himanshu Joshi took an entire day session on movie '*Zindgi naa melegi dobara*' where students learnt to overcome their fears by trying new things, looking at things from a broader perspective and resorting to self introspection. Shri Haresh Tandel from 'Patanjali Yog Peeth' held a session on every day need of 'yoga' exercises. All students were taken to a campus tour in small groups. They were familiarized with other departments of the University such as a Pharmacy, MBA, MCA, Bio-Technology, Engineering, and Nursing etc. They also experienced a 'Quiet Time' at 'Shrimad Museum'.

The results of the previous academic session stood at an average of 88% in BBA and 83% in B.Com (CA). Distinction and first class was secured by 30% in FY BBA, 28% in SY BBA, 18% in FY B Com. and 33% in SY B Com. The syllabus was finished on time according to the planned teaching schedule and all academic programmes were completed on time.

Indigenously designed 'Attendance Monitoring Information System' was successfully applied in monitoring students' attendance. The attendance has been above 80% throughout the year.

This academic year the college procured 916 books for BBA and B.Com. A sum of Rs. 326162/- were spent on books, journals and magazines during the year. All students were issued three to five text books each for the entire semester under book bank facility besides printed hand outs on various subjects.

This year an amount of Rs 3, 38,565.00 was received from the State Government towards scholarship for 12 ST students and Rs. 21875 for 13 SEBC students. Scholarships for SC students are yet to be received.

The college has been able to retain all its 17 teaching staff except one during the academic year.

This academic year six research papers were presented by the faculty. The faculty members got ample opportunities to participate in seminars, workshops and conferences outside the college. Also, one faculty member was awarded M Phil. degree and three others qualified the UGC.-N.E.T for eligibility for lecturer ship.

At the Institute various extracurricular and co curricular activities were executed and managed by committees and clubs formed for the purpose. Sports committee organized inter class sports tournaments for volley ball, table tennis, badminton, chess, carom, scrabble and cricket. Women team of the college bagged championship at inter college volley ball competition. Institute hosted dance and fine arts activities at Youth and Techno Festival organized by Uka Tarsadia University and Forum of Private Universities of Gujarat. Also, during five day orientation programme “SAPTATARA” jointly organized by Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat, Gandhinagar and Uka Tarsadia University dance activities were hosted by the institute. Highlight of the cultural programme organized by the cultural club this academic year was inter college Garba competition where 300 students across different disciplines participated and added colour to the festivities of Navratri. Random act of kindness club organized visits to Old-Age Home, Primary School and Slow Learners’ centre where members spent time with lonely inmates and presented utility items to them. Twice during the academic year alumnus interacted with students. As an endeavor towards holistic development of students 102 beginner adventure enthusiasts went on a trekking trip to Pandavva caves near Ahwa in Dang in October 2012. 102 students of BBA along with faculty members participated in ‘Management Students Program in Confluence 2012, the annual business summit of IIM Ahmedabad’ in November 2012. 150 students took part in General Awareness Competition organized by management club.

To develop students to keep pace with industry practices 217 students of BBA were taken for industrial visits in different organizations viz., NTPC, JK Paper Mills, SUMUL Dairy, Nuclear Power Corporation of India Ltd., Parle G, Hindustan Unilever, Balaji Wafers, Sugar factories, etc.

Nil incidences of ragging and sexual harassment were reported during the academic year 2012-13.

The Annual Function was held on 20/3/2013. Prizes were given to students for various academic and co-curricular activities. The college spent around Rs. 38,000/- on the celebrations.
