Uka Tarsadia University participated in the 2nd AIU National Women Student Parliament 2023-24 organized at the Parul University, Vadodara. It was a three-day event spanning from 9th to 11th April 2024. More than 30 universities from across India participated in the event.

Three students Khushi Kevat (BA JMC Sem 4) from the Department of Humanities, Tisha Kedar (BTech CSE Sem 2) from the Asha M Tarsadia Institute of Computer Science and Technology and Sakshi Singh (BBA Sem 4) from the B V Patel Institute of Management were selected as participants after the two screening rounds to represent the Uka Tarsadia University on the national stage. Priya Sahani, a faculty from the Department of Humanities was selected as a team manager.

Upon arrival at the venue, all three participants and the team manager were welcomed with flowers and a gift hamper containing a Mug imprinted with their name, Diary, Pen, Visiting Card holder and Calendar. Each team was appointed a Liaison officer. The food and accommodation of the participants was arranged at the Girls Hostel of the campus while the food and accommodation of the team managers was arranged at a resort near the campus.

Day 1 (9th April 2024)

The day began with a team manager meeting, where all the team managers introduced themselves and spoke about their university. All the guidelines of the four rounds were discussed. The topic for the first day was 'Women Reservation Bill- 2023'. A lot of draws

were used to select which team would speak in government or opposition. The team of UTU spoke in favour of the bill. They represented the Prime Minister, the President and the Whip. Each of them spoke for 3 minutes. Unfortunately, the team got eliminated in the preliminary round. Team managers also gave a video byte sharing their experience.
