**Topic: The Future of HR: A Business perspective by:**

**Dr. Nirav Mandir**

- The different challenges business face while growing including main aspects such as lack of productivity.
- One of the main challenge any business face is lack of talent.
- There is a strong need of identification of gap between labor's supply and business demand.
- The focus of business is always on performance and productivity.
- Another major challenge he discussed was the role of government or government's interference in business.

**Shri Soarabh Pathak:**

- To navigate the future workforce landscape.
- There are 3 main elements for any business: Understanding, Retaining and Upskilling.

- There are changes or revolution in technology such as AI and Machine Learning.
- It is very important to make align the workforce landscapes with the employee learning methods.

**Shri Vikram Tandon:**

- The future of analytics is not just about HR but mainly about business.
- Adult learning is learning from the life lessons.
- Creation of a culture where everyone is provided an opportunity to express.
- Make line managers more accountable by recognizing their skills and strength.
- Make yourself replaceable by doing succession planning.

**Prof. Bharat Bhasker:**

- Today is the era of rapid changes which used to take 10-20 years now happens within a couple of months.
- The new HR challenge will be to create a synchronization between humans and robots.
- Humans will have to learn and change themselves along with robots to increase productivity and capability.
- HRs will have to get aligned with the robot to enhance the human capabilities, sustain the process, etc.
- HR will be the middleman between robots and humans.

**Admiral Shri R. Harikumar :**

- You drive the business or it will drive you.
- Leadership is not just about solving problems but about democratization, decidedness', demand and disruption.
- Delegation of authority and responsibility is a must when you are managing people.
- Try to find out new ways for communication even at the bottom level of human resources.

**Panel Discussion outcomes:**

- Many questions were raised by different industrial managers and students present there, the answer of which were given by panelists.

- The industry experts gave their point of views on every question asked which focused mainly on the practical aspect by providing their real life day to day occurring examples.
- They stated that their biggest challenge was in finding the right fit for the job even after having a huge supply of labors in the market.
