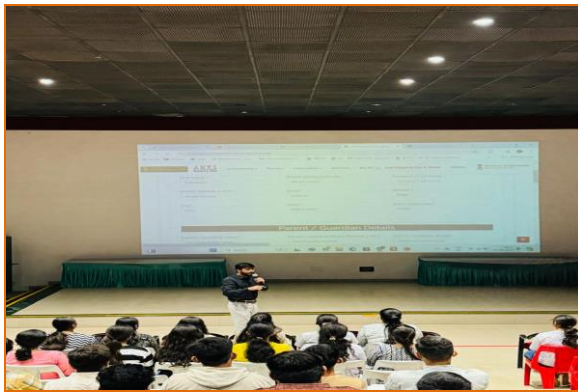
An Anti-Ragging Awareness Program and Affidavit Form Fill-Up session were organized on 21st August 2024 at B.V. Patel Institute of Management in compliance with the guidelines issued by the University Grants Commission (UGC). The event aimed to educate students about the dangers of ragging, promote a safe and respectful campus environment, and ensure the mandatory submission of anti-ragging affidavits by all students.



Who emphasized the importance of creating a ragging-free campus? This was followed by a detailed presentation by Dr. Taral Patel covering the following key topics:

- Definition and forms of ragging.
- Legal consequences of engaging in ragging.
- The psychological and physical impact of ragging on victims.
- The role of students, faculty, and administration in preventing ragging.
- UGC's regulations and the importance of the anti-ragging affidavit.

The presentation also included real-life case studies to highlight the severe consequences of ragging and to create a deeper understanding among the students.
